## Key Features:

### Flower

Abundant flowers with unusually notched triangular petals create an interesting mass effect.

### Easy to Grow

Easily grown in average, medium to wet soil in full sun. Divide clumps every 3-4 years to maintain vigor.

### Visitors to Explore

Beneficial pollinators are attracted to these blooms, including honey bees, bumblebees, and some butterflies.
