Leaves

Fan-like leaves have delicate black stems and mossy green leaflets that combine for a soft texture in the garden.



Spring Color

When fiddleheads are sprouting in late spring and early summer, they sport a cherry red stem before turning a satiny black.



Native Alternative

When planted in groups, this delicate fern is a beautiful alternative to invasive ground covers like sweet woodruff and periwinkle.
